Please note: Student enrolment registration details submitted & held in strict confidence.

Groups as follows:

Show workshops as required & by arrangement.

Specialist workshops & Soloist instruction are by arrangement.

Each weekly workshop will be charged for, as Stage Door Studio operates during secular school term times. Workshops are to be paid each week or four weeks in advance, price on application (Special workshops may be held if required e.g. for show work etc, at no extra cost).

As a courtesy, notice is required from the parent / guardian if the student is ill or away on holiday. Should a student miss their usual workshop they may attend another one if applicable, by prior agreement with the group leaders.

All classes held during the term are to be paid for on a continuous basis.

Should a workshop not be paid for, no more than one week will be allowed to lapse & after this time the student will not be entered into the workshop, unless by prior consultation & at the discretion of the workshop leaders.

Please Note:

We remind parents that Stage Door Studio is only responsible for their child during their allotted workshop times and students should be collected promptly at the end of their workshop.

Should a student be absent for 3 weeks or more without notification, they will then be excluded from Stage Door Studio & re-registration will apply.

STAGE DOOR STUDIO THEATRE WORKSHOP

Code of Conduct & Standards 2021 onwards:

This code will be to the benefit of all involved in the workshops, aiming to help students gain in confidence & to ensure that performances are of a high standard, having fun & sociable time whilst in attendance.

Discipline: All persons in attendance are required to have respect for each member of the workshop, including tutors & visiting guests. The workshop will operate in an atmosphere of discipline & fun. There will be a break time during each workshop for socialising, drinks & snacks may be purchased if available.

In such cases where a person unbalances the equilibrium of the workshop the leaders of the group reserve the right to refuse entry or exclude them. Three verbal warnings or immediate dismissal will take place, should unreasonable behaviour result & parents will be informed.

Should a member of the group be missing on three consecutive occasions without prior consultation, the leaders reserve the right to exclude that person from the workshop (as a whole) or a particular stage number, should a performance be imminent. (Illness or excess workload will be taken into consideration)

Dress Code: General smart appearance of students is required at all times. Hair is to be clean & tied back where appropriate. 'Stage Door Studio' tops are to be worn during workshops, along with other smart, clean tops when approved of by the leaders of the group.

Smart, black pants along with black jogging pants & black leggings are required during normal workshops as these allow freedom of movement. (Jeans are not acceptable) Black jazz / modern shoes are to be worn. (Other shoes may be required for show work)

Requirements: A no-smoking policy exists at Stage Door Studio from May 2000 during workshops as part of the commitment to health of students & tutors alike.

Chewing gum is not permitted at Stage Door Studio under any circumstances.

Damage to property within the rooms will be not tolerated, as all in attendance are responsible for good standards of maintenance whilst using the rooms.

All the usual workshops will be charged for during term time. Holiday dates need to be given in writing at least two weeks in advance.

Mobile telephones are to be switched off, except those of the group leaders.

All work is to be carried out in a non-smoking environment with caring & responsible members of DBS / CRB checked staff in attendance.

Data Protection and GDPR: The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) will give people greater control over how companies and organisations use their personal data.

The contact details you provide on this form will be used by Stage Door Studio for administrative purposes and to keep in contact about our work. The information is stored on a secure computer spreadsheet and locked filing cabinet that only Stage Door Staff has access to. If your child leaves Stage Door Studio, we will keep their data for 6 years at which time it can be securely disposed of. However, under GDPR you have the right to control yours and your child's data and withdraw consent to our data processing at any time by contacting us on 01422 200334. If your child is still part of Stage Door Studio upon their 16th Birthday, we will ask them to recomplete their form and provide their own consent.

The GDPR also covers photographs and video content. Any photographs and video footage taken of your child by Stage Door Studios will be used in promotional materials on behalf of Stage Door Studio Theatre Workshop including our online platforms and DVDs. The images and video footage collected by Stage Door Studios will be centrally stored on our secure server for as long as Stage Door Studios is operational and may continue to be used for retrospective purposes. Again, consent can be withdrawn at any time by contacting us as above.
